



Children will take part in Running Club on Tuesdays and Thursdays covering between 2-4k, however, students can complete kms independently at home. We will start our 10 week training block in week 3.

Ponsonby Primary School team but are waiting to hear back from the organisers. Registration is \$25 and you have up until midnight on the 2nd September. After this date the cost goes up to \$35.
