The Thursday program for our students gives them the opportunity to access a broader curriculum and really foster independence. We also kicked off the Year 6 leadership Program. It was fantastic to see the vision the Year 6 leaders have for their groups this year. We will keep you posted around the great work these groups will be undertaking this year. We will also be presenting each Yr 6 student their badge either this term or next term when we can eventually run assemblies.

We are taking great care of your children and we are looking after our staff - we are doing everything possible to keep things as normal as we can.




