

Homework-Will start in week 3



Homework will consist of a reading book, spelling words, high frequency words and a Mathseeds log in. Children's Mathseeds log ins will be glued into the front of their reading log.



A reading book will go home each night Mon-Thurs and a poem will go home on Fridays.



Pick a time that suits you and your child for homework. Shouldn't take too long.



















Literacy-Reading, Phonics, spelling and storywriting





Shared book in class, follow up activity, Teacher to do reading groups. Your child will take home a little reader Monday-Thursday. Please read with them and sign off in reading log.



High frequency words/sight words will be sent home to compliment the level your child is reading at.



















Phonics, Storywriting, Spelling



Phonics is the skills of segmentation (Spelling) and blending (reading) PLUS a knowledge of the alphabetic code.



Year 1s and 2s use Yolanda Soryl Phonics. We look at the sounds letters make, how to write them, items/pictures associated with that sound. blending sounds together to make words. (Use the robot)



Children will be given spelling words per week from the Essential lists. This will compliment the children's storywriting. Spellings checked on Friday
































Distance Learning


