Ponsonby Primary Weekend Weather Forecast




Saturday.

Areas of morning fog, then showers developing, possibly heavy from afternoon . Northeasterlies developing.




Sunday.

Nomination round


Our school will be undertaking a parent election for 5 School Board vacancies. This process will start with the issuing of nomination papers to our caregiver community by Friday 15th July 2022.



We look forward to your participation in this process.






Learn to Ski and Snowboard
