This year, we will be celebrating 150 years since our school was first opened. We will be celebrating this milestone in Term 3. More information will be sent out during the year on the various celebrations we will hold for our community and the learning the children will be doing regarding this celebration.

A little bit of history about our school! Ponsonby Primary school was originally established in 1873. The school was developed after a meeting of householders. Dedwood District, Church Street School was its first name. It was originally in the rented church hall. In 1876, ¾ of an acre was bought for the new school. In 1879 the school designed by Edward Mahoney opened and was leading edge architecture with its big open air well ventilated classrooms. The school outgrew itself and by 1898 the school was also part of the existing Church Street School. The district was named in 1881 Ponsonby and due to overcrowding a new school was built on Curran Street. Curran Street School was completed in 1921 and the pupils first attended in 1922 with Mr Hill as the first Principal of the newly sighted 2 large block building.

Don't forget to talk to your child about their day and engage with them on the activities they do at school. This partnership strengthens the learning that takes place at school, and your whanau and household will always be your child's first teacher!
