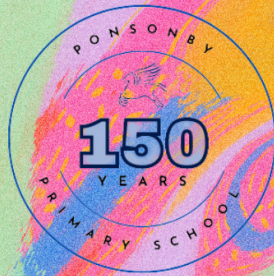
Room of the week Room 23
